



Kaplan University/EANGUS Guardian Scholarship Program

Kaplan University and the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS) have joined forces to implement an academic scholarship program to meet the needs of EANGUS and EANGUS Auxiliary member and their families.

- ▶ The program will award up to 6 full scholarships. In addition, 50 partial scholarships will be awarded, each covering more than half the cost of an undergraduate degree at Kaplan University.* To apply, applicants must have a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) in their most recent program of study (high school or college).
- ▶ This academic scholarship program will operate in two separate rounds to allow EANGUS-affiliated students greater flexibility and opportunity to earn a scholarship award and attend college on their schedule.
 - Application period 1 will run from February 15 to May 13, 2016, and application period 2 will run from June 1 to July 29, 2016. Three (3) full scholarships (undergraduate or graduate) and up to 25 partial tuition scholarships (undergraduate only) will be awarded per application period.
